Commendations: Kim has contributed to Meadowlark through her leadership on several projects including the Lark News—a video newscast put on by students and supervised by Kim. She also initiated our We Love to Read Month activities for students. Kim has shown great flexibility in her daily instruction in order to meet the needs of a wide range of students from highly gifted to those with special needs. She is supportive of students and their families and she encourages student independence and engagement in their own learning as demonstrated by her student lead conferences. I have observed Kim using many best practices in instruction as well as class management. She plans for student engagement. Kim is a great collaborator as well.

Student Learning Goal: To improve performance as measured on STAR assessment from the current 70% at and above benchmark to 83% at and above benchmark. Kim and her teammate have been using STAR progress monitoring. They use Reads Naturally and have designed projects to engage students and they use workshop organization and student conferencing. Students are journaling as well, which gives them a quick formative look at student progress.

Professional Practice Goal: Our team will create and find assessments that correlate with ELA CCSS. Kim and her teammate are using Oakland writing units and Readworks. They have designed projects for student engagement. They have also used Teacher Pay Teachers for lessons and assessments. They hope to use ScootPad. They will meet with our instructional coach to plan close reads and a rubric for assessing end of unit projects for non-fiction.
